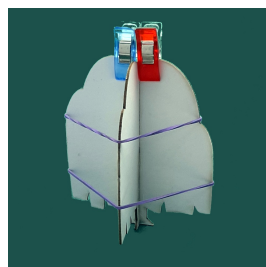
Step 1 – Tree

and glue

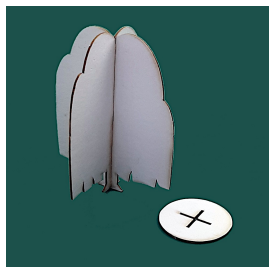


Position and clamp
until dry

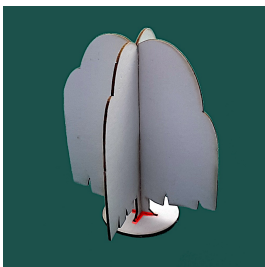


Tree assembly

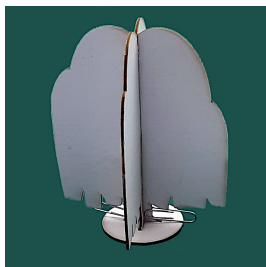
Step 2 – Tree base



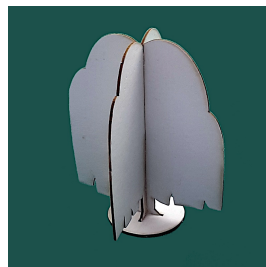
Assemble parts

assembly



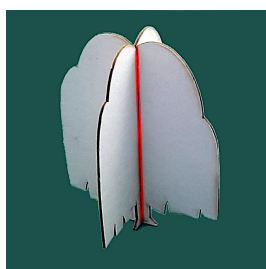

Large Tree

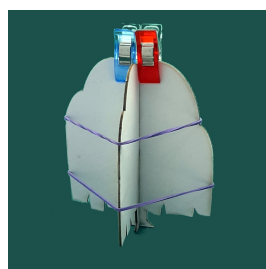
Step 1 – Tree



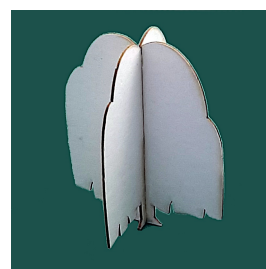
Assemble parts

and glue

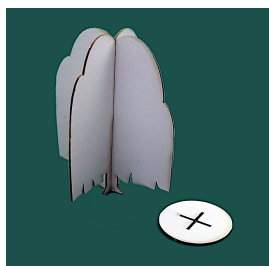


Position and clamp
until dry

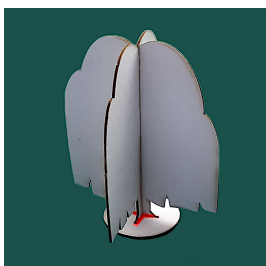


Tree assembly

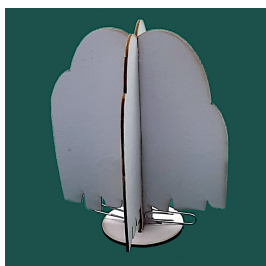
Step 2 – Tree base



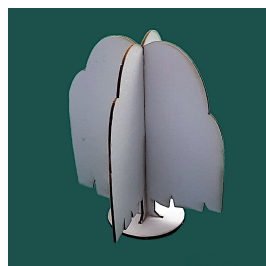
Assemble parts

Weeping Tree

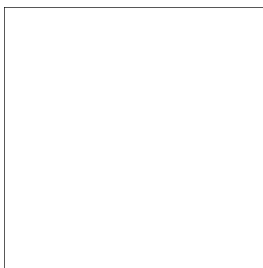
Finishing

Step 1 – Seal



Spray all surfaces with lacquer sanding sealer.

Step 2 – Prime

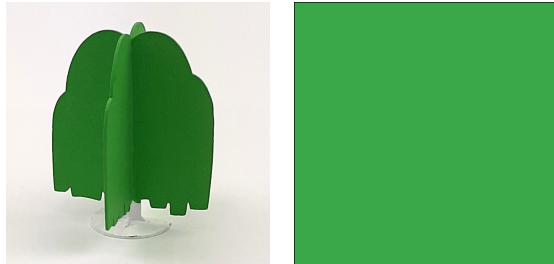


Prime all surfaces white.



Weeping Tree

Step 3 - Canopy



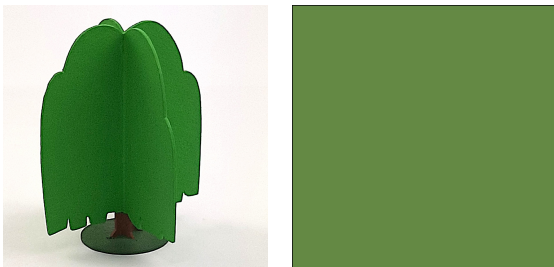
Paint the canopy
spring green.

Step 4 - Trunk



Paint the trunk
dark brown.

Step 5 - Base



Paint the base
grass green.
